

**COMPLAINT INVESTIGATION SUMMARY**

**COMPLAINT ISSUES:**

Whether the New Albany-Floyd County Consolidated School Corporation violated:

511 IAC 7-27-7(a) by failing to implement the student's individualized education program (IEP) as written, specifically by failing to:

- (a) address the student's goal of writing in complete sentences;
- (b) address the student's goal of counting money/making change; and
- (c) address the student's goal of telling time.

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

1. The Student, 17 years old, is identified as a student with autism-spectrum disorder, and has been determined eligible for special education and related services.
2. The Student's IEP dated March 14, 2006, indicates that the Student is in a functional English class and contains an objective that "[The Student] will write in complete sentences with 60% accuracy 5 out of 10 data collection days with model and/or verbal prompts." According to the Special Education Teacher's Data Collection Sheets and the Teacher of Record's Data Log, this objective was addressed 35 out of 44 school days.
3. The Student's IEP dated March 14, 2006, indicates that the Student is in a functional math class and contains an objective that states "[The Student] will count out a variety of change using all coins and bills with 80% accuracy 5 out of 10 data collection days with verbal prompts." According to the Special Education Teacher's Data Collection Sheets, this objective was addressed on 37 out of 44 school days.
4. The Student's IEP also indicates an objective that states "[The Student] will tell time to the ¼ hour with verbal prompts 5 out of 10 data collection days with 80% accuracy." The Data Collection Sheets indicate that the objective was addressed on 25 out of 44 school days.

**CONCLUSION:**

Findings of Fact #2 through #4 indicate that the School has addressed the Student's goals and objectives specifically related to: (a) writing in complete sentences; (b) counting money/making change; and (c) telling time. Therefore, a violation of 511 IAC 7-27-7(a) is not found.

**The Department of Education, Division of Exceptional Learners requires no corrective action based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions listed above.**
