Subject: Summer of Learning Grants

The Indiana Department of Education's (IDOE's) 2023 Summer of Learning Grant [application](#) is open now through Friday, October 28. In the summer of 2022, this grant supported 14 conferences throughout the state, providing opportunities for nearly 4,000 Indiana educators to learn about teaching and learning in technology-rich environments. Public school corporations, charter schools, and non-public schools, or collaborations may apply to host one of these conference opportunities.

These conferences will return next summer, offering more opportunities to connect with innovative, technology-enhanced pedagogy related to:

- Supporting underserved populations;
- Science of Reading;
- Integrated STEM;
- Designing virtual and blended learning experiences; and
- Community connection and support.

School corporations can request up to \$18,000 in the grant application, and applications require collaboration details, an outline of required learning strands, details about the proposed conference, budget, and assurances.
